Glass recycling is not available at this time. **PRACTICE COMPOSTING** by using microorganisms (mainly bacteria and fungi) to decompose organic waste, such as food scraps and yard trimmings.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:** dispose properly of leftover household products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive ingredients that can pollute the environment and pose a threat to human health. Currently Texarkana does not have a drop off location for Household Hazardous Waste, please consult the EPA's website for more information on proper disposal.
